BILL

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Goa for the services and purposes of the financial year 2000-2001.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Goa in the Fifty-first Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- 1. Short Title.— This Act may be called the Goa Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 2000.
- 2. Issue of Rs. 17,02,67,000 out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Goa for the financial year 2000-2001— From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Goa, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (5) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sums of seventeen crores two lakhs and sixty seven thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course for payment during the financial year 2000-2001 in respect of the services and purposes specified in column (2) of the Schedule.
- 3. Appropriation.— The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Goa under this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said financial year.

Statement of Objects and Reasons

The Supplementary Demands for Grants for the Year 2000-2001 (First Batch) was presented to the Legislative Assembly on 26th July, 2000. This Bill is introduce in pursuance of Article 204 read with Article 205 of the Constitution of India to provide for the Appropriation of certain further sums out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Goa to meet the expenditure on certain services during the financial year 2000-2001 in excess of the amounts granted by the Legislative Assembly for those services.
