BILL

*further to amend the Goa Prevention of Defacement  
of Property Act, 1988.*

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Goa  
in the Fifty-second Year of the Republic of India as  
follows:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) This Act  
may be called the Goa Prevention of Defacement  
of Property (Second Amendment) Act, 2001.

(2) It shall come into force on such date as the  
Government may, by notification in the Official  
Gazette, appoint.

2. *Amendment of section 3.*— In sub-section (1)  
of section 3 of the Goa Prevention of Defacement  
of Property Act, 1988 (Goa Act No.5 of 1990),—

(i) for the words “one thousand rupees”, the  
words “five thousand rupees” shall be  
substituted;

(ii) for the existing proviso, the following shall  
be substituted, namely:—

“Provided that in the interest of tourism and  
economic activities of the State of Goa, the

Collector or any other authority authorized by the Government in this behalf, may, allow displaying of any board or hoarding at any public place and, for activities necessitating digging of a public road, allow such digging, on such terms and conditions and at such rates as may be notified by the Government by notification from time to time."
