BILL

further to amend the Legislative Diploma No. 1984 dated 14-4-1960, in its application in the State of Goa.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Goa in the Fifty-second year of the Republic of India, as follows:—

- 1. Short title and commencement.— (1) This Act may be called the Goa Legislative Diploma No. 1984 dated 14-4-1960 (Amendment) Act, 2001.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Amendment of Article 16.— In Article 16 of the Legislative Diploma No. 1984 dated 14-4-1960, in Clause (3), for the expression "for a period of three years" the expression "during the pleasure of the Government", shall be substituted.

Statement of Objects and Reasons

Article 16 of the Legislative Diploma No. 1984 dated 14-4-1960 provides for the composition of a Council, which consist of the Chairman and four other members, out of which three will be non--official members. Clause (3) of said Article 16 provides that the term of the non-official members shall be three years. In case, the Council is not functioning properly or if the Government desires to remove the non-official members of the Council for any reason, there is no provision in the said Legislative Diploma for the Government to act and re-constitute the Council of Provedoria as and when required by it. It is, therefore, proposed to amend said clause (3) of Article 16 of the said Legislative Diploma so as to provide that the non-official members of the Council shall be on the Council during the pleasure of the Government.

This Bill seeks to achieve the above object.

ANNEXURE

Extracts of the Goa Legislative Diploma No. 1984 dated 14-4-1960, Enactment No. 1984

Article 16

- 1. The Conselho da Provedoria (herinafter referred to as the 'Council') shall consist of Chairman and four other members, including the Provedor, who shall be the Member-Secretary of the Council.
- 2. The Chairman and other three members of the Council shall be appointed by the Government by notification in the Official Gazette.

Provided that the Chairman shall be on Officer of the Government.

3. Every non-official member of the Council shall hold office for a period of three years and shall be paid such allowances from the funds of the Provedoria as may be fixed by the Government.
