BILL

further to amend the Goa Salaries and Allowances of Ministers Act, 1964 (Act 3 of 1965)

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Goa in the Fifty-Second Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. Short title and commencement.— (1) This Act may be called the Goa Salaries and Allowances of Ministers (Amendment) Act, 2001.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of section 11.— In section 2 of the Goa Salaries and Allowances of Ministers Act, 1964 (Act 3 of 1965), for the existing clause (b) the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“ (b) “Family” means family as defined in the Medical Attendance Rules applicable to class I Officers of the Central Government.”.

Statement of Objects and Reasons

The current definition of "family" included in the section 2 (b) of the Goa Salaries and Allowances of Ministers Act, 1964 (Act 3 of 1965), applies to Members of the Legislative Assembly also under the Goa Salary, Allowances and Pension of Members of the Legislative Assembly Act, for entitlement of medical facilities. The definition does not include parents within the meaning of "family",. The defect is sought to be removed by this bill.

Annexure

Extract from the Goa Salaries and Allowances of Ministers Act, 1964 (Act 3 of 1965)

2. *Definitions.*— In this Act unless the context otherwise requires —

(b) "family means a wife residing with the husband and legitimate children and step-children residing with and wholly dependent on him; and where the husband has more than one wife, only one wife shall be included in his family for the purposes of this Act, If the Minister is a married woman, "family" shall include her husband residing with her;
