BILL

*further to amend the Goa Prevention of Defacement
of Property Act, 1988.*

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Goa
in the Fifty-second Year of the Republic of India as
follows:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) This Act
may be called the Goa Prevention of Defacement
of Property (Amendment) Act, 2001.

(2) It shall come into force on such date as the
Government may, by notification in the Official
Gazette, appoint.

2. *Amendment of section 3.* — In section 3 of
the Goa Prevention of Defacement of Property Act,
1988 (Goa Act No. 5 of 1990), after sub-section (1),
the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:—

“Provided that in the interest of tourism and
economic activities of the State of Goa, the
Collector may allow displaying of any board or
hoarding at any public place on such terms and
conditions and at such rates as may be notified
by the Government by notification from time to
time”.
