# The Goa Appropriation (No. 3) Bill, 2003

( Bill No. 13 of 2003 )

A

BILL

*to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Goa for the services and purposes of the financial year 2003-04.*

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Goa in the Fifty-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. *Short title.*— This Act may be called the Goa Appropriation (No. 3) Act, 2003.

2. *Issue of Rs. 31,55,80,64,000 out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Goa for the financial year 2003-04.*— From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Goa, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (5) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sums of thirty one thousand fifty five crores eighty lakhs and sixty four thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will arise for payment during the financial year 2003-04 in respect of the services and purposes specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

3. *Appropriation.*— The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Goa under this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said financial year.
