BILL

further to amend the Goa Salaries and Allowances of Ministers Act, 1964.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Goa in the Fifty-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) This Act may be called the Goa Salaries and Allowances of Ministers (Amendment) Act, 2002.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of section 3.*— In section 3 of the Goa Salaries and Allowances of Ministers Act, 1964 (Act 3 of 1965) (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Act"), in sub-section (2),—

(i) in item 1, for the figures "7,000/-", the figures "10,000/-" shall be substituted;

(ii) in item 2, for the figures "6,500/-", the figures "9,500/-" shall be substituted;

(iii) in item 3, for the figures "6,000/-", the figures "9,000/-" shall be substituted.

3. *Amendment of section 4.*— In section 4 of the principal Act,—

(i) after the words "Each Minister", the figures and words, "except the Chief Minister", shall be inserted;

(ii) for the expression "seven thousand rupees per month", the expression "ten thousand rupees per month" shall be substituted.

4. *Insertion of new section.*— After section 4 of the principal Act, the following section shall be inserted, namely:—

"4A. *Constituency office allowance.*— Each Minister, except the Chief Minister, using a premises in his Constituency for the purpose of his office, shall be entitled for an allowance of rupees three thousand per month,".
