BILL

further to amend the Goa Salaries and Allowances of Ministers Act, 1964.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Goa in the Fifty-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. Short title and commencement.— (1) This Act may be called the Goa Salaries and Allowances of Ministers (Amendment) Act, 2002.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of section 3.— In section 3 of the Goa Salaries and Allowances of Ministers Act, 1964 (Act 3 of 1965) (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Act"), in sub-section (2),—

(i) in item 1, for the figures "7,000/-", the figures "10,000/-" shall be substituted;

(ii) in item 2, for the figures "6,500/-", the figures "9,500/-" shall be substituted;

(iii) in item 3, for the figures "6,000/-", the figures "9,000/-" shall be substituted.

3. Amendment of section 4.— In section 4 of the principal Act,—

(i) after the words "Each Minister", the figures and words, "except the Chief Minister", shall be inserted;

(ii) for the expression "seven thousand rupees per month", the expression "ten thousand rupees per month" shall be substituted.

4. Insertion of new section.— After section 4 of the principal Act, the following section shall be inserted, namely:—

"4A. Constituency office allowance.— Each Minister, except the Chief Minister, using a premises in his Constituency for the purpose of his office, shall be entitled for an allowance of rupees three thousand per month,".
