BILL

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Goa for the services and purposes of the financial year 2006-07.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Goa in the Fifty-Seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

- 1. Short title.— This Act may be called the Goa Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 2006.
- 2. Issue of Rs. 41,60,62,17,000 out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Goa for the financial year 2006-07.— From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Goa, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (5) of the Schedule to this Act amounting in the aggregate to the sums of four thousand one hundred sixty crores sixty-two lakhs and seventeen thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will arise for payment during the financial year 2006-07 in respect of the services and purposes specified in column (2) of the said Schedule.
- 3. Appropriation.— The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Goa under this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule to this Act in relation to the said financial year.
