BILL

*further to amend the Indian Stamp Act, 1899
(Central Act 2 of 1899), as in force in the State
of Goa*

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of
the State of Goa in the Fifty-seventh Year of the
Republic of India as follows:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) This
Act may be called the Indian Stamp (Goa
Amendment) Act, 2006.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force
with effect from the 10th day of May, 2006.

2. *Amendment of Schedule I-A.*— In Schedule
I-A to the Indian Stamp Act, 1899 (Central Act
2 of 1899), as in force in the State of Goa, in
article 5, after clause (b), the following clause
shall be inserted, namely:—

“(bb) if relating to an agreement for the sale of an immovable property.

Rupees 100/- for property valued upto Rs. 1 lakh or part thereof and for property valued in excess of Rs.1 lakh upto Rs.5 lakhs, Rs.500/- per lakh or part thereof and for property valued in excess of Rs.5 lakhs, Rs.1,000/- per lakh or part thereof”.

3. *Repeal and saving.*— (1) The Indian Stamp (Goa Amendment) Ordinance, 2006 (Ordinance No. 4 of 2006), is hereby repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal anything done or any action taken under the said Ordinance shall be deemed to have been done or taken under this Act, as if this Act was in force on the day on which such thing or action was done or taken.
