The Goa Appropriation (No. 7) Bill, 2010

A

BILL

to provide for the authorization of appropriation of moneys from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Goa to meet the amounts spent on certain services during the year 2006 – 2007 in excess of the amounts granted for those services and for that period.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Goa in the Sixty First Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. *Short title* – This Act may be called the Goa Appropriation (No. 7) Act, 2010.

2. *Issue of Rs. 9,07,428/- out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Goa to meet excess expenditure for the year 2006 – 2007* – From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Goa, the sums specified in column (5) of the Schedule hereto amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Nine Lakhs Seven Thousand Four Hundred and Twenty Eight Rupees shall be deemed to have been authorized to be paid and applied to meet the amount spent for defraying the charges in respect of services specified in column (2) of the said Schedule for the year 2006 – 2007 in excess of the amounts granted for those services and for that period.

3. *Appropriation* – The sums deemed to have been authorized to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Goa under this Act, shall be deemed to have been appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the said Schedule for the year 2006 – 2007.
