BILL

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Goa for the services and purposes of the financial year 2012-13.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Goa in the Sixty-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- 1. Short title.— This Act may be called the Goa Appropriation (No. 3) Act, 2012.
- 2. Issue of Rs. 314,08,89,000 out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Goa for the financial year 2012-13.— From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Goa, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (5) of the Schedule hereto amounting in the aggregate to the sums of three hundred fourteen crores eight lakhs eighty nine thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in the course of payment during the financial year 2012-13 in respect of the services and purposes specified in column (2) of the said Schedule.
- 3. Appropriation.— The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Goa under this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the said Schedule in relation to the said financial year.
